## BETA SOFTWARE POLICY

The Budapest Home Office strives to update the software of the SCIO with an updated version of the software released every October in connection to the World Conference in Budapest, Hungary. However, an updated version of the software requires strict control, testing, and documentation to ensure that the latest version of the software is stable and effective.

Therefore, we have established a testing procedure called “BETA Testing.” After changes to the software go through the “BETA Testing” procedure and are approved, then it is officially released by the Budapest Home Office. This is important for ensuring the stability and effectiveness of the software, maintaining compliance to the registrations, and allowing all Technical Support to offer the best service if you have difficulties with the software.

Any version that is created outside of the officially released version in connection with the World Conference in Budapest, Hungary is NOT an authorized version of the software unless specifically stated on the Budapest Home Office’s website [www.qxsubspace.com](http://www.qxsubspace.com). Sometimes an updated version of the software is given out during a conference but is NOT BETA Tested and therefore NOT completely verified, documented and approved for release. You may be told that these changes may serve as a temporary fix or solution to some issues. Please be aware that utilizing a software that is handed out during a conference, seminar or training event is NOT an official software update and therefore is NOT approved and released by the Budapest Home Office. If you are using any version other than the one on the website [www.qxsubspace.com](http://www.qxsubspace.com), then you are using a version that is not officially approved and released. This means that there may be some glitches that have not yet been found and resolved. This may also mean that Technical Support may not have a copy of the version that you are using and may not fully be able to help you.

To find out which is the current official software update that is approved and released, please visit the website of the Budapest Home Office [www.qxsubspace.com](http://www.qxsubspace.com) and check under “Software Updates.” This will tell you the current version as approved and released by the Budapest Home Office.

Please always keep in mind that the first contact for assistance in software and technical issues is to be the Support Staff of the Broker from whom you’ve purchased your device.

The goal of the Budapest Home Office is that there will be one (1) release of a software update in connection with every World Conference. The World Conference is held in Budapest, Hungary every October and is sponsored by the Budapest Home Office.
